THE COOL BLOCK ONE-ON-ONE "INFORMATION MEETINGS"

Are you doing several 1-1 Cool Block "Information Meeting" briefings to complement your gatherings? If so, we recommend you use this formula.

- Welcome and Purpose General brief statement, plus what motivated you and why you are committed
- Cool Block video
- Ask them them a few introductory questions –
 How long have you lived here?
 Why are you interested to hear more about The Cool Block?
- Say a few things to contextualize the Cool Block pilot:
 - It is happening in SF, LA and Palo Alto
 - it spans about 20 blocks in each city; we are piloting the program to get it ready to scale as part of the "Cool City Challenge"
 - Cool Blocks are distributed across each city, in many different neighborhoods
- Vision share your own highest vision for the block, and ask them to take a moment to think about theirs (around resourceful living, resiliency, safety, livability, community building)
- Use the <u>Cool Block Topic Schedule</u> handout to give an overview of the topics and flow of the program
- Provide the <u>How the Program Works</u> handout and talk through it together
- Describe the team that is forming on your block, and ask them to join you. If they say YES thank them! If they have questions or concerns, ask about them and support them. Do not push, but gently pull and leave the door open.
- For those who say YES -- Let them know next steps -- *Team-Building Meeting (when?)
